Working with SDG in following dimensions

The 5 tracks of reporting / working:

- At the national level – reporting at 240 UN indicators
- Partnership with stakeholders
- SDGs on municipality level
- SDGs in the private sector
- SDGs in "danish" – leaving no one behind

1: At the national level

- 240 Indicators adopted by UN in 2015
- A shared responsibility – every country can do something better
- Statistics Denmark show the status of Denmark as a nation and reports to the UN
- We expect to report on 150 indicators this summer
- Our platform is continuously expanded with new indicators in the following year
- Reporting takes place with the involvement of stakeholders



2: Partnership with stakeholders

- Stakeholders: State and municipal authorities, private sector representatives, interest groups, social partners and NGOs
- Continuous meeting series on data sources, activities and experiences
- Consultations on methods and sources
- Best possible reporting given availability of data
- Information about initiatives
- Exchange of experience



3: SDGs at the municipal level

- Many municipalities have SDG activities
- But the municipalities' challenges and activities are very different
- Collaboration with the municipalities' association to combine common goals and individual goals
- Statistics Denmark designs a website that can be integrated into the municipalities' own websites



4: SDGs in the private sektor

Great interest from the companies in SDG:

- Seen as a competitive parameter and as a risk
- Pilot project has been initiated
- All companies with more than 300 employees answer the questionnaire
- The overall idea is to show which goals Danish companies work with
- The results can then be distributed according to brans, turnover, etc.



5: The SDGs in danish

- The context is: leaving no one behind
- Not all sub-targets are relevant for Denmark
- The purpose is to review all sub-goals and insert goals that make sense in a Danish context
- We conduct a consultation process and a number of workshops for all 17 SDGs
- The purpose is to create a common understanding of what is particularly important in a Danish context
- The supplementary goals must be measurable
- The process will run in the coming year
- All stakeholders will be invited
